

Homily



Today is the 2nd Sunday of Ordinary Time. Prophet Samuel was able to respond to calling of the Lord with the help of his teacher old Eli. Also Peter was able to say 'yes' to calling of discipleship of Jesus with the help of John the Baptist and his brother Andrew. Eli, John the Baptist, and Andrew all have been ardently waiting for the salvation of God. In order go establish the kingdom of God there has to be those who are ardently waiting for salvation and preparing for it. The will of God is not done naturally, but requires our ardent prayer and will.

John the Baptist proclaims Jesus as the Lamb of God. The Israelites were able to escape the slavery of Egypt with the blood of one year old lambs. In the New Testament blood of Jesus gives us new life of true salvation. Andrew professes Jesus as the Messiah, who is Christ. The Savior of mankind is the Lamb of God, the Savior who saves us from sins, death, and darkness, new life to with His blood and death.

The Savior is the 'Lamb of God', a true leader and a teacher of humankind. He cleanses our filths and vices with his own pure blood. He saves us from our sins and darkness. Saviors of mankind carry out this tremendous work not with power or arms, high status or riches but opposite. But by obeying God and keeps the words of God he cures the sinful world. The Savior who saves us keeps the words of God totally with his purity and chastity. He sheds blood for that.

Paul the apostle, in the 2nd reading today, lets us keep in mind that we are the members of Christ. He urges us to reveal the power of Jesus' salvation with our bodies. And he continues to say that we have to use our body not for immorality but for the Lord. He says that when we use our body totally for the Lord, we can be united with Christ and become one spirit with Christ. Paul very clearly points out the danger of immorality.

"Avoid immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body,
But the immoral person sins against his own body. Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you have been purchased at a price. Therefore glorify God in your body."

Those who follow the Lord have to strive to reveal the glory of God with their body. They are living the life of 'the Lamb of God.' They participate in the way of the Lord, are the disciples of the Lord, and answer to the words of the Lord. They participate in the salvific way of the Lord in this way. Eli, John the Baptist, Peter, and Andrew are among them. This is to answer to the calling of the Lord. We have to reveal the glory of God with our bodies.

Name 'Peter' has the meaning of 'rock'.

Jesus builds his Church on this rock. This rock is the rock of the Lamb of God. This rock reveals the glory of God with our bodies. We Christians are all called to reveal the glory of God. We have to try our best to use our body holy. It is the reason Peter is called to be the disciple of Lord.

Liturgy Q&A

A brief history of the Tabernacle A brief look at the history of the tabernacle and why it exists will help you understand why there is a common misconception between the altar and the tabernacle. The center of the church is the altar, the place where the Eucharist is celebrated. The blessing of the altar is the centerpiece of the church's dedication ceremony.

From the earliest days of the Church, the church was used to bring the Eucharist to those who were imprisoned for their faith, or to those who were ill and unable to attend Mass. The practice of preserving the consecrated bread during Mass has existed since the 7th and 8th centuries, when documents show the Eucharist being kept in a sacristy. The sacristy was probably the most appropriate place to store the Eucharist, both to easily preserve the consecrated bread during Mass and to store the Eucharist for use outside of Mass.

Then, in the Middle Ages, a strange phenomenon began to occur in the piety of the faithful: a kind of "ethical rigorism," in which we are inevitably sinners. The idea that we are inevitably sinners and how can we receive the Eucharist with a sinner's heart, became so widespread that people began to avoid receiving Communion during Mass. And it was virtually impossible for the faithful to actively participate in a Mass that was said in Latin, a language they did not understand. So, it's no wonder that they were more drawn to this phenomenon than to the Eucharist itself. The belief that Jesus was present in the Eucharist. that the Eucharist was the body of Jesus, tugged at the hearts of the faithful. Therefore, the faithful do not receive Communion, but instead "look" at the Eucharist, not receive Communion, but instead aspired to have the honor of "looking" at the Eucharist. This aspiration eventually culminated in the Eucharistic Liturgy, when the priest, after consecrating the bread and wine, holds up the consecrated bread and wine. The faithful also wanted to place the Eucharist, which is Jesus, in the most exalted place in the church, and hence the creation of the tabernacle.

In response to the aspirations of the faithful, the Tabernacle overtook the Altar and took its place in the center of the church. The Tabernacle came with ornate decorations and the practice of keeping a red light on at all times to indicate the presence of Jesus.
