Homily



First Lent of 'B' year

Dear parishioners and everyone, hello! I entered the Catholic University of Seoul in 1982. Among my fellow freshmen were Father Kim Nam-Gil Dae-geon Andrea and Father Kim Young-kwan Dominico. You know both of them very well since they were your ex-parish priests. Father Kim Nam-Gil was the previous priest who has been with you for the last five years and just left. Father Kim Young-kwan is the priest who was with you for seven years ago. Father Kim Young-kwan and I was classmate since elementary school and also from same parish. We grow up together, and know each other pretty well. Father Kim Nam-Gil used to give spiritual guidance to the seminarians. Both of them are spiritually excellent and have rich experiences in ministry. Although it is comforting to have two former classmates as fellow priests, on the other hand, I felt my new assignment burdensome since I fall short compared to them. Saint Paul said "I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth." So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is everything, but only God who allows the growth. We are co-workers of God, and you are God's field, and building. Father Kim Young-Kwan sowed the seed by constructing the church, while Father Kim Nam-gil provided deep spiritual nourishment. With the belief that God is the one who makes it grow, I will work together with you for building kingdom of God. Nice to meet you!

In today's first reading, God presented to the people of Israel rainbow as a symbol of forgiveness. Through this symbol, God promised not to judge

the people of Israel with water or fire ever again. During my meditation I thought what kind of symbols I might bring to St. Andrew Kim. When I received a letter of appointment as a pastor to St. Andrew Kim of Dallas I thought of a sign of rainbow as the symbol I might bring. I received another sign. Jesus said, "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. I lay down my life for the sheep." I consider showing the life of a good shepherd like Jesus as my symbol, guide line. In today's second reading, another symbol is mentioned which is baptism. Through baptism we became children of God, and we became brothers and sisters. St. Paul explains the meaning of baptism "Baptism is not a washing away of the dirt from the body but an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ." What is a good conscience? Jesus showed us what a good conscience is. First, it is a heart of compassion. Jesus healed the sick with a compassionate heart. Jesus fed over five thousand people because he pities them. Jesus spoke of God's mercy and compassion through parables of the lost coin, the found sheep, and the returning son. Second, it is a humble heart. Jesus always urged his disciples to be humble. The greatest virtue in overcoming the temptation of evil is humility. Jesus washed the feet of his disciples, setting an example for them to follow. He said, "I have come to serve, not to be served." Third, it is a heart that knows shame. Judas betrayed Jesus but did not feel shame and took his own life. Peter also betrayed Jesus but felt shame, shed tears of repentance, and was forgiven. Zacchaeus knew shame for his wrongdoing, repented, and shared his possessions with the poor.

Jesus said "Today, salvation has come to this house." Fourth, it is a discerning heart. Jesus said "Do not worry about what to eat, what to drink, or what to wear. Instead, seek God's righteousness and His will." Our standard of discernment is basis that reveals the glory of God. To resist Satan's temptation, we need to be close to God's word. God's word is the foundation of our lives. Today, Jesus says in the Gospel "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news." What is the good news? It is to practice the words spoken by Jesus. It is to live a life of service. What is the good news? It is to believe in Jesus Christ, who died on the cross but rose again, as our Savior. Believing in Jesus Christ as our Savior means that we are already living in the kingdom of God in this world and will receive eternal life even after death.

Liturgy Q&A

Liturgy Q&A
 Gathered Assembly
 Christ is always present in the Church, particularly in her liturgical celebrations. In the celebration of Mass, which is a memorial of the sacrifice of the Cross, Christ is truly present in the assembly he gathers to himself: "Where two or three come together in my name, there am I in their midst." (Mt 18:20)
 At Mass, the faithful form a holy people, a people whom God has made his own, a royal priesthood, so that they may give thanks to God and offer the spotless Victim not only through the hands of the priest but also together with him, and so that they may learn to offer themselves. They should, moreover, endeavor to make this clear by their deep religious sense and their charity toward brothers and sisters who participate with them in the same celebration. Its structure and ordering are a reflection of the Church herself, governed and served by the bishop, priests, and deacons. The celebration is organized to encourage and foster an awareness of the liturgical assembly's common dependence on God and each other as well as its common dignity and purpose.
 The dialogues between the priest or the deacon and the congregation and the acclamations have special value as signs of communal action and as means of effective communication. Singing is an important expression of communal awareness and purpose. Uniformity in posture and gesture expresses and fosters a unity of spirit and purpose. Accommodation should be made to facilitate the participation of persons with special needs. Care should be taken to recognize the needs of children who may be a part of the assembly. In particular cases where the greater part of those participating are preadolescent children, the adaptations provided in the Directory for Masses with Children may be used.
