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Homily



First Sunday of Advent

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ.

During my vacation, I had a joyful reunion with my classmates from the seminary. Our gathering was held at the mission station of Jumunjin Parish, where one of my classmates—who had previously served in the United States—was recently assigned. The community has about twenty parishioners, and as we arrived, the chickens and a friendly dog in the vard welcomed us warmly. We entered the seminary in 1982, and now fortythree years have passed. Although we began by talking about politics, economics, and culture, our conversation eventually returned to memories from our seminary days. One friend and I once ran the school store together. Another traveled with me during difficult times. One asked me years ago to give a speech supporting him, and I did so gladly. Another had lived with me in Canada twenty years ago. One had many childhood memories with me because we grew up in the same parish. One visited Dallas last summer because he has relatives there. Another helped me with the Sunday evening Mass for three years. One accompanied me on vacation. As we greeted each other and shared our stories, the conversation blossomed with warmth, and in their faces I could see the depth and maturity shaped by thirty-four years of priestly ministry.

Today is the First Sunday of Advent, the beginning of a new liturgical year. Though one month still remains on the secular calendar, the Church begins her new year today. For this reason, the theme of today's Gospel is "watchfulness." There are two dimensions to watchfulness. The first is simply waking from sleep. I myself rose at four o'clock this morning, and you, too, are here because you awakened. Every living creature that wakes does so with two purposes: survival and the preserva-

tion of its species. This is the realm of the strong devouring the weak and the survival of the fittest.

The other dimension is spiritual wakefulness, which we may call enlightenment. Created in the image of God, we gain spiritual insight as we walk the path toward Him. In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks of this very kind of awakening. Spiritual enlightenment also has two forms. One is the grace that comes purely as a gift of God's mercy. On the road to Emmaus, the disciples encountered the risen Lord, and as He spoke to them, their hearts were burning within them. The other form is the enlightenment gained through deep reflection and spiritual discipline, just as the Buddha achieved enlightenment through seven years of ascetic practice and shared that insight with others.

Two things are necessary for spiritual enlightenment. The first is opening the door of one's heart. When the heart is open, even the uneducated, even foreigners, even sinners, can receive God's love and mercy as a gift. Jesus once reminded the hardened hearts of the Jewish leaders: "During the time of Elijah, when a severe famine struck the land, God's miracle was worked for the widow of Zarephath, a foreigner. And in the time of Elisha, although many in Israel had leprosy, only Naaman the Syrian was healed." The Pharisees and scribes, although well-versed in the law, did not receive God's mercy because their hearts were closed. Jesus also said, "Do not worry about what you will eat, drink, or wear. Your heavenly Father knows all that you need. Seek first His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." He continued, "Look at the birds of the air and the flowers of the field. They neither toil nor spin, yet God cares for them. Do not worry." And again He said, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. My yoke is easy, and my burden

The second way to enlightenment is trusting in the Word. Jesus overcame tempta-

tion through the Word. The Word is the "navigation" that guides us on the path of enlightenment. The history of salvation began when humans responded "yes" to the Word. The Blessed Mother answered, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be done to me according to your word." Saint Joseph, who had planned to divorce Mary quietly, listened to God's word and welcomed her as his wife. Jesus Himself prayed, "Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me; yet not my will but yours be done." The Holy Family lived entirely in obedience to God's Word. Adam and Eve lived in paradise while they remained within the Word, but when they forgot the Word and fell to temptation, they were cast out of the garden.

As we begin the new liturgical year of 2026, may we open the doors of our hearts with humility and gentleness, so that God's love and grace may be given to us as a gift. And may this year be a time in which we grow in enlightenment through God's holy Word. "So stay awake, for you do not know on which day the Son of Man will come."
