Homily



Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ!

One of the greatest joys of being a parish priest is meeting the faithful. Among those encounters, the most meaningful are not meeting those whom I need, but meeting those who need my help. About a month ago, a sister who had been healthy began to feel unwell and went to the hospital. She was told to visit a larger medical center. After a biopsy, she was diagnosed with cancer, already widely metastasized. Ascites developed and was drained, but soon returned. I visited her home to administer the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Anointing of the Sick. This sister, who had been away from the Church for a long time, received the Eucharist with great joy, like the Israelites who ate the manna in the desert. Her husband, who had no faith, said that he wanted to start coming to church. When I suggested that we pray together for his wife, he gladly agreed. Her mother, over eighty years old, came out to greet me without even putting on her shoes. With the mother’s earnest prayers and a husband willing to pray alongside her, we asked that she might regain enough health to live again with her family. She even willingly gave up her scheduled physical therapy so that someone who was more seriously ill than herself could receive treatment. That is why today’s first reading tells us “I will make you a light to the nations, that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth.” And today’s responsorial psalm sings “O Lord, I delight in doing your will; your law is written in my heart.”

On Sunday afternoon, three events took place. First, there was the blessing of a newly opened restaurant called Sura, owned by one of our parish brothers. He serves as an altar server with his son, and his wife volunteers in the religious goods shop. Altar serv-

ers also attended the blessing. We prayed that the business would prosper and that those who eat there would be nourished and healthy. After the blessing, I attended the year-end gathering of the Ignatius Group, a fellowship of men in their fifties. These brothers are like the backbone of our parish, serving faithfully in many ministries. One brother, not yet baptized, shared that he had searched in many places for God but could not find Him; however, when he came to church, his heart found peace. He believed it was the earnest prayer of his 93-year-old mother-in-law that led him to the church. The brothers wrapped up the year with fellowship and a raffle, resolving to serve even more faithfully in the coming year. After the gathering, I went to the evaluation meeting for our charity concert, where musicians and volunteers reflected together. They gladly accepted my suggestion to hold a music retreat next year. Sharing these three events made my body tired, but seeing parishioners living their faith with joy filled my heart with happiness. I was reminded of Saint Paul’s words “Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.” And today’s Preface proclaims “You have freed us from sin and death and made us a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people set apart, so that we may proclaim your mighty works, for you have called us out of darkness into your own wonderful light.”

In our parish, there are people who truly become a light to the nations. There are people who delight in doing God’s will. There are people who proclaim to the world the power of the Lord who called us out of darkness into marvelous light. During the past Advent season, many joyfully participated in Scripture copying. Through this, they engraved God’s word in their hearts and shared that word with their neighbors. There are those who visit a brother lying in a hospital bed every single day, simply to keep him company. Anyone can do it for a day or two, but doing it daily is not easy. Yet they continue to visit, listen, and gently massage his aching body. There are also many who

pray every day. For the 50th anniversary of our parish in 2027, we committed to offering one million decades of the Rosary. In just one month, more than 100,000 decades have already been offered. On Holy Thursday, each neighborhood took turns in Eucharistic Adoration. Jesus asked His disciples to stay awake and pray with Him in the Garden of Gethsemane. Some sisters stayed up all night praying. I prayed with them as well, but even one week was difficult for me. Today’s Gospel comes to mind “I have seen and testified that He is the Son of God.” Because there were witnesses like John the Baptist who testified to the Son of God, the Church has grown for over 2,000 years. And because there have been parishioners who, like John the Baptist, testified to the Son of God, St. Andrew Kim Korean Catholic Church in Dallas has grown for the past 50 years.
