Homily



Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ. It has been about ten years since our parish church was built. Overall, there have been no major issues, but recently a problem has arisen at the outdoor children’s playground. The wood chips that were laid down for the safety of the children have been washed away by rain, and over time they have begun to decay. The pastoral council discussed two possible options. One was to lay down new wood chips as before, and the other was to level the ground properly and install artificial turf. Some felt that artificial turf would look better, and others suggested that it would be good to proceed quickly since the children are currently on break from school.

Last year, we also carried out a storage room renovation. At that time, many of our brothers volunteered their skills, and the result was a beautiful and solid new storage room. This time as well, we believe the playground will become a safer place for our children. We decided to work every Saturday, and the women’s group kindly volunteered to prepare lunch. Hiring contractors would have been costly, so we chose instead to rely on the strength and generosity of our parish community. During the preparation, someone reminded us that we needed permission from the city first, and so we followed the proper procedures. I feel truly blessed to have brothers who love this parish and sisters who joyfully prepare meals with generous hearts.

As we began planning this project, I was reminded of the storage room renovation that took place two years ago. That project started in February and was completed in June. If we had hired contractors, it might have been finished in just one month. But instead, our brothers donated their talents, and our sisters prepared meals. Over the course of four months, I witnessed the passion and dedication of our parishioners. I also came to realize that in the United States, where labor costs are high, many tasks must often be done by our own hands.

The brothers who worked on that project

are now actively serving on our pastoral council. They installed new drainage in the parking lot where water used to collect after rain. They removed dead trees and planted new ones. They replaced more than eighty air conditioning filters. They renovated the basketball court floor. They served as safety volunteers during our parish walkathon. They helped clean up after Parish Day. At the Dallas-area interchurch soccer tournament, they prepared delicious Korean soup for everyone while other teams ate instant noodles, we shared a warm, hearty meal together. I am truly happy to serve a parish blessed with parishioners who willingly dedicate themselves to the good of the community.

Happiness, we are told, cannot be achieved simply by filling ourselves with more and more things. Our desires are like drinking seawater the more we drink, the thirstier we become. True happiness comes from knowing the purpose of our existence. A person is happy when living as a true human being. And human beings are created in the image of God. Therefore, we find true happiness only when we live according to God’s will. In the Gospel of Luke, chapter 19, we hear the story of Jesus meeting Zacchaeus on the road to Jericho. Zacchaeus had accumulated great wealth, yet he felt empty inside and longed for a meaningful life. People despised him and pointed fingers at him, calling him someone who cared only about money. But Jesus called Zacchaeus and chose to stay at his house. Through this encounter with Jesus, Zacchaeus discovered what true happiness really is. He declared that he would give half of his possessions to the poor, and if he had cheated anyone, he would repay them fourfold. Had Zacchaeus never met Jesus, no one would remember him today. We remember him because he met Jesus, and because his life was transformed by that encounter.

From Jesus’ teaching, we learn that those who are truly blessed those who enter the Kingdom of God are the ones who care for the poor, the marginalized, and the vulnerable, and who unite themselves with them. Caring for our neighbors in need and sharing our hearts with them is not optional for believers; it is our responsibility. Such a way of life leads us directly into the Kingdom of God. Saint Paul teaches us that true happiness does not come from status, ability, or family background. He says, “Christ Jesus

became for us wisdom from God, as well as righteousness, sanctification, and redemption. This is God’s doing, so that, as it is written, ‘Whoever boasts, should boast in the Lord.’” We have come to know Christ freely through faith. We are called to become Zacchaeus of our own time, to seek true happiness. Now we know the path that leads to that happiness. Just as we feel reassured when we see a signpost pointing toward our destination, may we keep our eyes fixed on the Lord, our true signpost, and faithfully walk the path of happiness, the path that leads us to God.

“Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.”
