Homily



Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ. There are some sayings we may have heard before “Even if the sky falls, there is a way out.” “Even if you are caught by a tiger, keep your wits about you and you will survive.” “And even if the world were to end tomorrow, I would still plant an apple tree today.” Just as leaves are shaken when the wind blows, we too are influenced by external circumstances and changing situations. But as long as the leaves remain firmly attached to the branch, they do not fall easily. In the same way, when we keep our minds clear and stay calm, a path will always reveal itself.

A young couple traveled to Paris, France, at the end of the year. They attended Christmas Eve Mass at Notre Dame Cathedral and enjoyed their time, even doing some shopping at department stores. However, while organizing their return flight, they realized they had left behind their permanent resident card. When they contacted the embassy, they were told that since they were not U.S. citizens, they would need to apply online. This meant staying an additional week or more, disrupting their schedule. The husband began thinking of possible solutions. One idea was for the wife to go to Korea while the husband returned to the United States, retrieved the permanent resident card, and brought it to her in Korea. This would allow them to return on time, but it would be expensive.

Another option was to apply online for replacement documents, which would cost little but require staying in Paris for more than a week. Then a better solution

came to mind. They asked a friend in the United States to send the permanent resident card from their home via FedEx. This option was inexpensive and allowed them to return as scheduled. Although they were initially shocked, once they found a solution, the couple was able to enjoy the rest of their time in Paris and return home safely with the card that arrived by courier. What mattered most was their trust in one another and their ability to stay calm and look for a solution rather than panic.

I had a similar experience myself about fifteen years ago. I was traveling in Spain with a fellow priest from my seminary class. We rented a car in Madrid and planned to return it at the Barcelona airport before flying back to Korea. I assumed our flight was international and went to the international terminal. My friend followed me. However, since we had a layover in Madrid, we actually needed to go to the domestic terminal. We waited for quite some time before being told that we were in the wrong place. By the time we rushed to the domestic terminal, it was already too late. Missing the flight back to Korea would have affected my Sunday Mass schedule. Fortunately, although it cost more, we were able to purchase new tickets and return safely. What mattered most was the trust and patience of my fellow priest, who waited for me without complaint and even shared the additional cost. Situations can always change. But when we keep our minds clear, there is always a way forward.

Today’s readings show us the path that leads to the Kingdom of God. If we live according to this path, no matter what winds blow or what hardships come our way, we can begin the Kingdom of God here on earth and receive eternal life even beyond death. Today, the prophet Isaiah tells us “Share your bread with the hungry, and take the poor and homeless into your

home. When you see the naked, clothe them, and do not turn away from your own flesh and blood. Then your light shall break forth like the dawn, and your wound shall quickly be healed. Your righteousness shall go before you, and the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard. If you give your bread to the hungry and satisfy the afflicted, then your light shall rise in the darkness, and your gloom shall become like midday.” Yes, this is the way of the Good Samaritan. Just as God is merciful, we too are called to become merciful people.

Saint Paul reminds us today that this path is not difficult. It does not depend on talent or ability, nor on family ties or social connections. He says, “My speech and my proclamation were not with persuasive words of wisdom, but with a demonstration of spirit and power.” Our faith does not come from human wisdom, but from the great grace of God. Finally, Jesus tells us today: “Let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.” May our words and actions become light and salt for the world.
