Homily



Third Sunday of Lent

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, There are seven last words that Jesus spoke from the Cross. We call them the Seven Last Words. Today I would like to reflect with you on one of them: "I thirst." What was Jesus thirsty for? He was walking the road to Calvary. He fell three times. He was nailed to the Cross. Surely He was physically thirsty. It would have been natural for Him to say, "I thirst," because His body needed water. Yet I believe there was something deeper in those words. Jesus once said, "The truth will set you free." What Jesus truly thirsted for was truth. He thirsted because people were living in lies and hypocrisy. He thirsted because people were consumed by desires for success and advancement. He thirsted because people were trapped in anger and resentment. Pilate asked Him, "What is truth?" Truth is believing that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. Truth is accepting the Kingdom of God that He proclaimed. Truth is believing that through Jesus Christ we receive eternal life.

It is now 2026. Even political leaders speak and act out of a kind of thirst. Nations pursue power, resources, and security. Arrests are justified by law, yet beneath them can lie economic ambition. Immigration enforcement seeks measurable results, yet in the process violence and injustice can occur. Precious lives can be lost because institutions are thirsty for performance and control. Former leaders have reminded the nation that America is a land shaped by immigrants. There are also geopolitical ambitions justified in the name of national security, yet underneath them can be a desire for natural resources and strategic dominance. This thirst for power and possession is like drinking salt water. The more one drinks, the more intense the thirst becomes.

On this Third Sunday of Lent, we must ask ourselves: What are we thirsty for? Are we, like Jesus, thirsty for truth? Or are we thirsty for wealth, recognition, and

control? A wise teacher does not merely give fish to hungry students. A wise teacher gives them a net. With a net, they can continue to fish even when the teacher is gone. What net did Jesus give us? The first net is the Church. Jesus said, "You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the Kingdom of heaven." The Church gives comfort and courage to the weary. The Church shows the path of Christ to those who wander. The Church guides those who are uncertain toward true happiness. True happiness is found in showing mercy, in working for peace, and in doing what is right before God.

The second net is the Sacraments. The Sacraments are visible signs of God's invisible grace. Through Baptism we become children of God. Through Confession we are reconciled with Him. Through the Anointing of the Sick we receive comfort and strength. Through Matrimony families are blessed. Through Confirmation our faith is strengthened. Through Holy Orders servants are chosen to proclaim and preserve the faith. Through the Eucharist we receive Jesus Himself. Our Lord said, "Take this, all of you, and eat of it, for this is my Body, which will be given up for you. Take this, all of you, and drink from it, for this is the chalice of my Blood, the Blood of the new and eternal covenant, poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this in memory of me." Those who receive the Sacraments within the Church founded by Christ drink the living water that never runs dry. Those who drink this living water learn to live in gratitude.

There are three levels of gratitude. The first is conditional gratitude "if" gratitude. If my child enters a good university, I will give thanks. If I receive a financial blessing, I will give thanks. The second is gratitude "because." I give thanks because things went well. Because my health report was good. Because I was promoted. Even in our spiritual life we often remain at this level. The third is gratitude "in spite of." Giving thanks even when things do not go as planned. Giving thanks that

something worse did not happen. Job lived this kind of gratitude. Even when he did not understand his suffering, he blessed the Lord. If he thanked God for good things, he also thanked God in hardship.

The Lord tells us, "My food is to do the will of the One who sent me and to accomplish His work." This is the nourishment He desired. May this Lent be a season in which we thirst not for power or possession, but for truth. May we drink deeply from the living water of Christ. And may our lives be filled with gratitude that does not depend on circumstances, but rests firmly in God's faithful love.
