

# Homily



Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, This past Ash Wednesday was a meaningful day in our parish. Until last year, we had only an evening Mass. During the meeting of the district leaders, someone suggested that it might be good to celebrate Mass twice. After discussing it with Fr. Yoon and the sisters, we decided to add a morning Mass this year. It turned out to be a good decision in the eyes of God. Many people came both in the morning and in the evening. I also received ashes on my forehead and carried them with me throughout the day. In a way, those ashes felt almost like a badge of honor, reminding me that I belong to Christ. During this Lenten season, Fr. Yoon also began a 40-day Bible reading program. It is not an easy decision or commitment. Yet it too is a choice pleasing to God.

Life, in many ways, is a series of choices. The historian Arnold Toynbee described history as a process of "challenge and response." When we make choices, the usual standard is ourselves what benefits me, what brings me honor, what gives me happiness. This is a natural tendency. In fact, all living things have evolved according to such instincts. But believers are called to make another kind of choice. St. Ignatius of Loyola called this process discernment. The standard for discernment is not ourselves but the greater glory of God. In the Spiritual Exercises (No. 23), St. Ignatius writes: For the greater glory of God, we may choose poverty rather than riches, illness rather than health, and even a shorter life rather than a longer one.

The path of faith is the path of discernment. Noah built the ark of salvation while others were eating and drinking. Abraham left his homeland and set out for an unknown land. He was even willing to offer his beloved son, born when he

was one hundred years old, on the altar to God. Naaman, the Syrian general, listened to the words of the prophet Elisha and washed himself in the Jordan River and he was healed of leprosy. Susanna chose death rather than a life of shame, and God revealed His glory through her by sending the prophet Daniel.

Today is Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord. In today's Gospel we hear about two different kinds of choices: those made for personal benefit, and those made for the glory of God. Pilate, Herod, the chief priests, and the scribes chose according to their own interests and power. In the name of God, they demanded that the Son of God be crucified. The crowd that once shouted "Hosanna!" while waving palm branches soon changed their voices and cried out, "Crucify Him!" Judas betrayed Jesus for thirty pieces of silver. Peter, who once declared he would follow the Lord even to death, denied Him three times. The disciples who had followed Jesus for three years all ran away. When I look back at my own life, I must admit that I too have often chosen my own interests rather than the greater glory of God. I preferred higher places rather than lower ones. I tried to avoid carrying the cross and sometimes passed it on to others.

Yet along the road of the Cross we also see those who discerned according to God's glory. There was Mary, the Mother of Jesus, who remained faithfully at His side. While the disciples fled, she stayed with her Son until the end. There was Simon of Cyrene, who carried the cross for Jesus and allowed Him a moment of rest. There was Veronica, who wiped the blood and sweat from His face. There were the women of Jerusalem, whom Jesus comforted even while He Himself was suffering. There were also many women who had encountered Jesus in their lives: the woman healed from hemorrhage when she touched His cloak, the mother whose daughter Jesus raised to life, the Syrophenician woman whose faith Jesus

praised, the woman forgiven of her sins who began a new life, and the woman who anointed Jesus' feet with perfume. And there was the criminal on the cross, who asked Jesus for mercy. To him Jesus said, "Today you will be with me in Paradise."

Scripture remembers all of these people. Today, on Palm Sunday, we are invited to ask ourselves: Where do I stand? Am I among the crowd shouting "Crucify Him"? Am I like Judas, who betrayed the Lord for silver? Am I like Peter, who denied knowing Him? Have I ever tried to protect my own power or reputation rather than stand with Christ? Or can I be like Simon of Cyrene, helping carry the cross of Jesus? Like Veronica, wiping the suffering face of Christ? Like Joseph of Arimathea, who remained faithful even after Jesus' death? If we stand among those who console the Lord, Jesus will say to us as well: "Today you will be with me in Paradise." The Kingdom of God proclaimed by Jesus did not end with the death of the cross.

Therefore St. Paul proclaims today: "Christ humbled Himself, becoming obedient to death, even death on a cross. Because of this, God greatly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the name above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend in heaven and on earth and under the earth and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."
