Homily



Easter Vigil (The Paschal Night)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, peace be with you.

I sincerely congratulate you on the celebration of the Resurrection. And to the fifteen catechumens who will receive Baptism tonight, I offer my heartfelt congratulations. On this holy night, you are not simply participating in a ritual—you are entering into a moment of grace, being reborn into new life. On behalf of our entire community, and as your priest, I warmly welcome and congratulate you.

Why do we celebrate? We celebrate a birthday because a new life has come into the world. We celebrate graduation because a long journey has been completed. We celebrate marriage because a new family begins. In 2002, when South Korea reached the semifinals of the World Cup, the entire nation rejoiced because a dream had come true. Our parish, St. Andrew Kim Catholic Church in Dallas, will celebrate its 50th anniversary in 2027. By God's grace, we have journeyed together for fifty years, and we are preparing many joyful events to commemorate this milestone. Whenever we celebrate, it is because there is a reason worthy of celebration.

I, too, have moments in my life that were worth celebrating. On August 23, 1991, I was ordained a priest after ten years of seminary formation, finally able to proclaim the Gospel. On October 1, 1999, I became a pastor for the first time, entrusted with a parish community. And on September 3, 2022, I received my green card, allowing me to remain legally in the United States and to serve here. At its core, celebration arises from something good that has happened. Then why do we celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord? If we truly understand the meaning of the Resurrection, our joy will be much greater. Without understanding, it can become just another annual event. But with un-

derstanding, the Resurrection becomes the very reason for our existence. We celebrate not merely to remember an event, but because the Resurrection is the foundation of our faith and hope. As Saint Paul says, "If Christ has not been raised, then our proclamation is in vain and your faith is in vain." The Resurrection is the very heart of our faith.

Christ has truly been raised from the dead. His Resurrection is the victory over sin and death, and the joyful proclamation that we are invited to share in new life. Saint Paul also urges us, "If you have been raised with Christ, seek what is above." The Resurrection is not only a past event—it is a power that transforms our lives today. Through the Resurrection, we discover hope beyond death and the promise of eternal life, and we celebrate this victory with joy and gratitude. For Saint Paul, the birth, public ministry, suffering, and death of Jesus once held little meaning. In fact, he persecuted those who believed in Christ. But on the road to Damascus, he encountered the risen Lord and experienced a profound conversion.

He became, along with Saint Peter, a pillar of the early Church. For the early Christian community, the Resurrection was not simply a miraculous event. It was a decisive turning point from fear to courage, from despair to mission. The disciples, who thought everything had ended with the Cross, were completely transformed after encountering the risen Lord. As Saint Paul proclaimed, "Christ has been raised," this became not only their confession of faith but the very reason for their existence. The Resurrection revealed that Jesus is truly the Son of God and declared that sin and death are no longer the ultimate power. That is why the early Church did not waver even in persecution and suffering, boldly proclaiming, "We cannot but speak of what we have seen and heard." The Resurrection was not merely a doctrine it was an experience, a hope, and the living center that united the community.

One truth is certain: a tree without roots cannot bear fruit. A Resurrection without the Cross is an illusion. And a Cross without the Resurrection is only suffering. The Resurrection in 2026 is not just a liturgical remembrance for me. It is God's invitation to begin again, here and now. The risen Lord tells His disciples, "Go to Galilee." Galilee is not merely a place—it is where we were first called, where joy and wounds, failures and hopes all coexist. The Resurrection is not only a promise for the distant future; it is a decision we make today. As Saint Paul confessed, "I have been crucified with Christ; yet I live, no longer I, but Christ lives in me." It is a present reality revealed in our lives.

Therefore, as people who celebrate the Resurrection, we are called to choose hope over despair, love over fear, and to take one step closer to those who are wounded. The Resurrection of the Lord is not just a story from two thousand years ago it is the event of new life that begins today in my own Galilee. Today, my Galilee is St. Andrew Kim Catholic Church in Dallas. Today, my Galilee is the family and neighbors I encounter. To the fifteen brothers and sisters receiving Baptism tonight, once again, congratulations. On this holy night, may the light of the Lord shine in your lives forever.

"Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me."

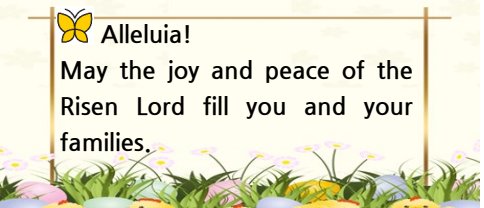
