Homily



Fourth Sunday of Easter
(World Day of Prayer for Vocations)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, peace be with you.

Today is the Fourth Sunday of Easter. The Church calls this day "Good Shepherd Sunday." At the same time, we observe it as the "World Day of Prayer for Vocations." On this day, we reflect deeply on God's holy calling and pray in a special way that vocations to the priesthood, religious life, and missionary service may flourish abundantly. However, in a broader sense, vocation is not a special path given only to a few. A vocation is the loving voice with which God calls each and every one of us.

I once served as the Director of Vocations for our diocese for five years. That time remains a very precious part of my priestly life. My responsibilities as Vocation Director were largely twofold: caring for those preparing to enter the seminary, and accompanying those already in formation. During that time, I also witnessed the ordination of four bishops. In 2014, when Pope Francis visited Korea, I served on the Spirituality Committee of the preparation team, helping to prepare prayer texts and materials. While working in the Vocation Office, I also participated in producing a documentary titled "Priest," which helped many people better understand the life of a priest and reflect more deeply on God's call.

A vocation is a response to God's call. Abraham was already in the twilight of his life. He was living quietly within familiar land, familiar relationships, and a familiar way of life when the voice of God came to him: "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you." Abraham did not calculate or set conditions. He simply believed and so he set out. That one step became the beginning of salvation history. Moses was tending sheep in the wilder-

ness when he encountered God in the burning bush. "I AM WHO I AM I am sending you." The staff ... in Moses' hand became God's instrument, and his steps became the path of liberation for his people.

On the shores of the Sea of Galilee, Peter was casting his nets when he heard the call: "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." Peter left everything and followed. Yet his journey was not without failure. He stumbled, denied the Lord, and wept bitterly. Still, Jesus did not abandon him. Rather, He called him again: "Feed my sheep." Peter became the rock of the Church not because he was perfect, but because he remained faithful to the call. The calling of Paul is even more dramatic. He was once a persecutor of the Church. But on the road, he heard the voice: "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" Though his eyes were temporarily blinded, his heart was opened. He changed direction, he changed his life, and he offered his entire being to the Gospel. The persecutor became an apostle; the man of the law became a man of grace. Indeed, God's call often begins in the most unexpected ways, and the life of the one who responds is never the same again.

In today's Gospel, Jesus says: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life." What kind of language did Jesus speak that people could recognize His voice so clearly? Jesus never hesitated to offer praise. He praised the widow's offering, the prayer of the tax collector, the faith of the centurion, and the faith of the woman suffering from hemorrhage. Jesus shared His power with His disciples the power to cast out demons and to heal the sick. The risen Lord gave them the Holy Spirit. Jesus remained with His disciples. At the beginning, He simply said, "Come and see." As they stayed with Him, they came to recognize Him as the Savior. Jesus spoke of sacrifice and service, saying that the greatest love is to lay down one's life for one's friends.

If we are generous in praise, if we are willing to share what we have received, if we walk together in both joy and sorrow, and if we do not hesitate to serve and to sacrifice, then we, too, will recognize the voice of Jesus. We will also begin to recognize the voice of our neighbors. Jesus also taught what it means to live as those who are called: "Freely you have received; freely give. Take no gold or silver or copper for your belts. Whoever wants to be first ... must be last. The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve. Whoever wishes to follow me must take up his cross and follow me." Those who respond to God's call must not cling to success, honor, or power. Rather, they must carry their cross. Jesus Himself carried His cross to the very end, even unto death. And it is upon that cross that the flower of the Resurrection blossoms.

Today is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. May we all faithfully respond to God's call. As those who have been called, may we humbly carry the crosses given to us for the glory of God. "Repent, and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."
