Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, Recently, I had a reason to be very grateful. The number of people attending Mass has been increasing. It has been two years since I came to St. Andrew Kim Korean Catholic Church in Dallas. At first, the number of people attending Sunday Mass was a little over 700. But recently, there have been many Sundays when more than 900 people came to Mass. On Easter Sunday, 1,155 people attended Mass. This was possible because of God's blessing and the dedication of our parishioners. I also heard some joyful news at a choir meeting. The number of choir members has increased, so the rehearsal room is becoming too small. They also said they would like to learn new hymns, but there is not enough rehearsal time. In Korean immigrant ministry, many communities are aging, and volunteers are often decreasing. But in our parish, volunteers are increasing. For this, I am truly grateful. This too is God's grace, and it is also thanks to the warm hearts of our parishioners.

There was another reason to be thankful. As the weather became hotter, several trees along the boundary of the church property died. But volunteers came out, spread compost, removed the dead trees, and planted new ones. Long ago, there was a cartoon called Mazinger Z. Whenever there was trouble, this robot would appear and help those in need. In our parish, we have brothers like that. Whenever there is a difficult job to do, they quietly appear, sweat, and serve. Before Mother's Day, the brothers prepared delicious meat for the mothers of our parish. They gathered together, cut the meat, and grilled it with great care. And for those brothers, the members of the Women's Association joyfully prepared a meal. Whenever I see such moments, I think to myself, "St. Andrew Kim Korean Catholic Church in Dallas is truly beautiful."

Thirty years ago, in 1996, there was a friend whom I used to visit when I brought Holy Communion to the sick. When he was in sixth grade, he fell on his way home from school, and that became the beginning of a serious illness. Gradually, his muscles became weaker. He could no longer walk, and

eventually he had to live in a wheelchair. But after receiving his First Holy Communion, he always rejoiced in receiving the Eucharist. He liked writing. One day, he showed me a short poem he had written: "This world is like the Milky Way filled with many stars. Because there are many stars, the night sky can be beautiful. But behind them, there is the dark sky of the universe. Just as the stars are beautiful because there is the night sky, this world can be beautiful simply because there are beautiful people in it." I have never forgotten that poem. His body was not free, but his heart was clearer and warmer than anyone else's. Through him, I learned something important. The world is not beautiful only because of capable people. It is not beautiful only because of successful people. The world is beautiful because there are people with beautiful hearts.

Our parish is the same. There are people who serve quietly in places that are not seen. There are those who clean the church, those who prepare meals in the kitchen, those who guide cars in the parking lot, those who serve in the choir, those who comfort parishioners in difficulty, and those who quietly offer donations and prayers. Because of such beautiful people of faith, the Church is beautiful. When we look at the history of the Church, we see the same truth. The Church has faced many trials and persecutions. There were heresies that denied the Holy Trinity. There were people who denied the divinity of Jesus. The early Christians were imprisoned and even killed because of their faith.

The Korean Catholic Church also suffered persecution. Many believers left their hometowns and lived in hidden Catholic villages deep in the mountains. It was difficult for them to meet a priest, and it was difficult to attend Mass. Yet they did not give up their faith. The Church is beautiful not because of magnificent buildings. It is not beautiful only because of excellent systems. The Church is beautiful because there have been beautiful people of faith who kept their faith until the end. The martyrs became people of faith who shine like stars. The 103 Korean Saints and the 124 Korean Blesseds still speak to us today: "Faith must be lived through love."

In today's first reading, the prophet Jeremiah is slandered and persecuted. But he does not fall into despair. He entrusts his pain and

injustice to God. His trials could not destroy him. Rather, they led him to a stronger faith. In today's Gospel, Jesus also says to us, "Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul." He also says, "You are worth more than many sparrows." As we live in this world, there are many things that make us afraid. Sometimes we are misunderstood. Sometimes we suffer loss. Sometimes we feel lonely. But Jesus tells us not to be afraid. He tells us not to run away from the cross. If it is a cross we carry because of love, then we must be willing to carry it.

In truth, what changes the world is not always some great power. It is one warm word. It is a drop of sweat shed for someone else. It is a quiet sacrifice. It is a beautiful heart that keeps the faith until the end. Today, Saint Paul tells us, "The grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ overflowed for the many." Jesus carried the cross for sinful humanity, and he gave us eternal life. Because of that love, the Church has continued until today. The world is beautiful simply because there are beautiful people in it. And the Church is beautiful simply because there are beautiful people of faith in it.

May we also become such beautiful people of faith. May we serve quietly, share joyfully, and never lose hope. And may St. Andrew Kim Korean Catholic Church in Dallas become a community that shines ever more brightly with the love of God.
