Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
(Pope's Sunday)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, The Chinese philosopher Zhuangzi once said, "A swift horse can run a thousand miles in a day, but it is of no use in plowing a field. A great pillar is necessary for building a house, but it is of no use in filling a small crack. An owl can see tiny insects at night, but in the daytime it cannot even see a great mountain." Zhuangzi teaches us that abilities, purposes, and natures are different, and therefore we do not need to compare one another carelessly. Just as the flowers in a garden reveal their beauty through different colors and fragrances, we also live with the place and the gifts that God has given to each of us. Some lead the community from the front, while others serve quietly from behind. Some praise God through singing, while others serve the community by washing dishes in the kitchen. What matters is not comparison, but faithfulness in the place God has entrusted to us.

A few days ago, the cover of my Bluetooth earphones came off. I use them every day while walking, so I wondered whether I should buy a new pair. But then I thought, "Why not just glue it back together?" So I bought a seven-dollar tube of super glue and carefully attached it. The mark is still visible, but it works perfectly well. Looking at it, I thought that faith is like this glue. In life, people often become separated. They become distant because of misunderstandings, and relationships break because of pride. People are divided by politics and ideology, and sometimes generations drift apart from one another. But faith has the power to join those cracks again. Those divided by misunderstanding can be joined with the glue of understanding. Those separated by hatred can be joined with the glue of love. Those divided by pride can be joined with the glue of humility. And if there is one glue that can bind everything together, it is the glue of faith, hope, and love.

At our recent priests' gathering, we listened to a lecture on the history of the Catholic Church in the United States and the history of Korean Catholic communities in America. It was very impressive. The Catholic Church

in the United States was not at the center from the beginning. It began in Florida through Spanish missionaries, and in the East through Catholic settlers from England. In a society where Protestantism was dominant, the Catholic Church remained on the margins for a long time. Yet Irish immigrants, German immigrants, and Italian immigrants kept the Church alive. For them, the Church was not simply a place to attend Mass. It was the ground of their lives. In the loneliness and hardships of immigrant life, the Church became their family, their shelter, and their hope. Through social services and education, the Catholic Church helped immigrants put down roots in American society. Eventually, with the election of President John F. Kennedy, a Catholic, the Catholic Church was no longer seen merely as a church on the margins, but became recognized as an important community within American society.

The history of Korean Catholic communities in America is also deeply moving. The Korean Catholic community that began in 1966 at St. Michael's Church in San Francisco has now spread throughout the United States. Communities in Maplewood, Philadelphia, and Washington, D.C. have already celebrated more than fifty years of history. This year, the Tacoma parish celebrates its fiftieth anniversary. And next year, our own St. Andrew Kim Korean Catholic Church in Dallas will celebrate its fiftieth anniversary. In the beginning, nothing was easy. Priests studying in the United States from Korea helped form the communities, and the faithful built them with tears and sweat in a foreign land. The language was difficult, the economic situation was not easy, and culturally they often felt lonely. Yet the faithful held one another together through faith. They shared kimchi, they shared soup, they shared tears, and in that sharing they built community. Through this priests' gathering, I was reminded once again that our St. Andrew Kim community in Dallas has grown in a very healthy way. This is thanks to the prayers and dedication of all of you.

Today, we celebrate Pope's Sunday in a special way. Many Americans also respect the Pope. There is great love for Pope St. John Paul II, and there is also much expectation and affection for Pope Leo XIV, who is from the United States. Why is that so? It is because the Pope is the glue of love that unites the Catholic Church throughout the

world. Though our languages are different, though our cultures are different, though the colors of our skin are different, we form one Church centered around the Pope. The Pope teaches us to place love, peace, and solidarity before the power and success of the world. Today's Scripture readings speak to us about the glue that makes our community of faith stronger. They speak of the glue that helps our community of faith draw closer to God. That glue is sharing. In the first reading, a poor couple shared a room and food with the prophet Elisha. Elisha then blessed them, saying that they would have a child. Jesus also speaks of sharing. He tells us that those who willingly share what they have will receive a great reward in heaven.

St. Paul tells us that this life of sharing is a new life. Jesus gave everything, even to the point of death on the Cross, and therefore he rose again. If we, too, can live a life of sharing like Jesus, the Holy Spirit will lead us to eternal life. As Jesus says in today's Gospel, "Amen, I say to you, whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones to drink because he is a disciple he will surely not lose his reward."
